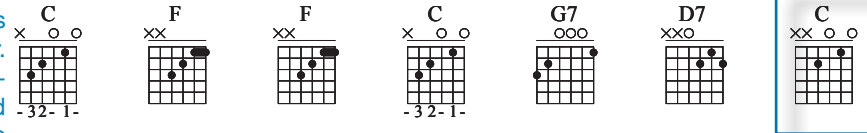


# Fisher's Hornpipe

I like to hold this C note for as long as I can to provide an anchor for the C form chord and to let the notes ring through each other. This also minimizes movement. As this shows hold it until the last beat of the 5th measure.

Again, I hold this first finger on the C note for 2 measures up to this point. It is not necessary buy if you can do this you minimize movement and give the song a very full and smooth sound.

Fisher's Hornpipe is another song that presents some challenging crosspicking opportunities for the beginning guitarist. Just remember to watch closely your down and up strokes and let the notes ring through each other and it will sound great.
