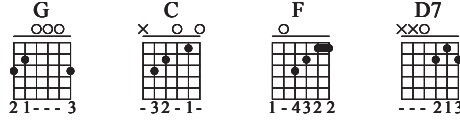


Red Haired Boy

The beginner version of Red Haired Boy is a very basic flat-picking guitar solo. Most of the measures are straight up-down picking with a few quarter notes thrown in. There is no syncopation issues and chord forms are at a minimum. You will not even have to wrestle too much with crosspicking. So this is a great song for the beginning flatpicker.
