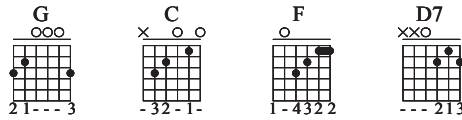


Red Haired Boy

Although this is a fairly simple song, that is without a lot of syncopation or ornamentation, it is a hard-driving song that is typically played up-to-speed at about 230bpm. This means close attention to timing and up-down strokes

Red-Haired Boy Ending

Nothing too difficult here. The ending tag follows the G form chord. Just be sure to prepare for the full G Major chord strum at the end. You do have the open G quarter note before it for some breathing room

We've added this "D" to the chord to make it sound even fuller than a normal open G major chord.
